3. What or who inspired you to study to become a teacher?

My paternal grandmother, who lived with us until I was 5, when she died, always wanted to be a teacher, but in her time she had to travel to Madrid to study for her degree, from Cuenca, where they lived, and my great-grandfather thought it was too "dangerous" for a woman to study in the capital. He used to talk to me a lot about this, and told me how he would have liked to study to become a teacher. This probably influenced me, and I got the idea.

4. What is your source of inspiration?

I always had the idea of becoming a teacher, but to find out if I was "predisposed" for this profession, at the age of 15 I had a nursery, with 35 children from 2 to 6 years old, because in 1975 there was still no nursery education in schools, and this was the litmus test. This was the acid test for me. I loved the experience. And even though I had to study the evening baccalaureate to be able to manage the nursery and my studies, it was worth it. It opened my eyes to see that this is what I wanted to do in my professional life.

5. What is the reason you get up every day?

Well, I am now retired, but during my professional life, every day I tried to go to work with joy, and with the intention that my students, as well as learning, would enjoy the process and be educated people, with values and a critical sense.


6. What is your favourite thing to do?
